Who is Centura Health?

Castle Rock Adventist Hospital Overview:

Situated between Denver and Colorado Springs, Castle Rock Adventist Hospital is a recently-built 55-bed acute care hospital and Level III Trauma Center providing comprehensive health care to the greater Castle Rock community and surrounding areas. From experienced emergency services to special deliveries in our state-of-the-art Birthplace with a Level II NICU, this hospital was built as a true community partnership between Centura Health and the people of Castle Rock. Area residents not only look to this hospital for care, but enjoy visiting its community gardens, outdoor spaces and restaurant. The ER is one of the busiest in the area – staffed with board-certified emergency physicians and specialty-trained emergency nurses. Our on-site imaging includes MRI, CT, ultrasound, X-ray and digital mammography. If you are looking for the close-knit feel of a modern, neighborhood hospital in a picturesque, family-oriented community that offers the very best of Colorado living, explore our opportunities.

Cardiac Cath Lab Department Overview:

The Cardiac Cath Lab at Castle Rock Adventist Hospital has one procedural lab that performs both Cardiology and Interventional Radiology Procedures. Nurses support a variety of procedures that include interventional cardiac procedures (STEMI, right heart cath, left heart cath), electrophysiology procedures (pacemaker insertions, loop recorders, cardioversions), diagnostic imaging procedures (CT guided biopsies, MRI procedures, ultrasound guided procedures), interventional radiology procedures (line placement, tube placements, paracentesis, biopsies). We offer a wide variety of opportunities for someone with strong critical care skills who enjoys assisting physicians and technologists with highly complex procedures. Team members learn how to perform in the Circulator role (medication administration, obtaining equipment for the case, monitoring hemodynamics) as well as the Monitoring role (documentation of case log). The team



includes a nurse, a cardiac/radiology technician, a physician and occasionally an anesthesiologist. Nurses without prior Cath Lab experience can join the Cath Lab Residency program which incorporates online, didactic, lecture and hands-on learning. This six-month orientation gives nurses experience performing a variety of procedures with the support of a preceptor. On-call shifts are required for this role to support emergent and urgent cases performed at nights and on weekends. Team members must be within 30 minutes of the hospital when on call. We prefer candidates with strong critical thinking skills, someone who likes to learn new procedures and technologies and enjoys working in a fast-paced team environment. Candidates must be able to use downtime wisely to grow their own knowledge and skill but be able to handle unexpected schedule changes as cases are added.

Emergency Department:

The Emergency Department at Castle Rock Adventist Hospital cares for about 18,000 patients per year in a 12-bed department. We care for patients of all ages from neonatal to geriatric. We are a primary stroke receiving center, support a cath lab, and are a Level III trauma center. We utilize collaborative practice and care for patients with a variety of diagnoses. The department is staffed with nurses, paramedics, critical care techs (EMTs), and unit coordinators that support our patients, physicians, and mid-level providers. It is our mission to provide outstanding patient care and elevate the patient experience by working as a cohesive and collaborative team.

General Surgical Unit:

The General Surgical Unit at Castle Rock Adventist Hospital is a 28-bed unit. We are a mixed medical surgical unit, treating general medical, cardiac, general surgical, ortho spine, joint replacement, stroke, trauma and a small amount of pediatric patients. Standard staffing ration is 1:4 on days and 1:5 nights as a goal, however can be a mix depending on specialties. Our department offers development opportunities and has a great culture that feels like a small community hospital where you develop relationships with the people within the hospital. Candidates must be team oriented with leadership ability, have positive attitudes, open to learning and are willing to work with others.

Intensive Care Unit (ICU):

The Intensive Care Unit (ICU) at Castle Rock Adventist Hospital is a mixed unit with cardiac, general medical and surgical patients. There are eight beds and we treat four to five patients per day. The culture and team within the ICU offer a healthy work environment with flexible scheduling. Our department delivers patient centered care with



quality outcomes, that are driven by teamwork. We look for candidates that are very team oriented and want to learn more.

Labor and Delivery/ Postpartum (LDRP):

The Labor and Delivery/Postpartum Department at Castle Rock Adventist Hospital has 13 beds and performs 75 deliveries per month. Our specialty is Labor Delivery and Postpartum where we care for families as they bring their new addition into their lives. Our department only sees pregnant patients. We are on a mission to be the best hospital in south Denver to deliver a baby. We have a very cohesive team that considers each other family. We do self-scheduling and each team member jumps in when needed to help the unit. We encourage staff members to continue their education and get their certificates in their area of interest. Candidates need to be motivated, self-starters and have a high energy.

Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU):

The Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) at Castle Rock Adventist Hospital has four beds, where three to five babies per month are admitted to the unit. Our department cares for babies that need a bit more attention and care. Our patient mix is pre-term infants which include infants who need oxygen. We have a team-centric culture. We have self-scheduling and support development opportunities. Candidates who join us must be self-driven and have high energy.

Surgery:

The Surgery Department at Castle Rock Adventist Hospital has five ORs and will perform about 250 surgeries a month. The variety of surgeries includes spines, orthopedics, GYN, robotics, GEN, urology, ENT, plastics, oral surgery and ophthalmology. We care for a variety of patients ranging in acuity. Our mission is to provide excellent care every day for every patient and every case. Surgery is a fast-paced collaborative unit that relies on teamwork to be successful. We look for candidates that have strong critical thinking, organization and are team oriented!
