The Histotechnician Extern is a twelve-month program designed to prepare associates with the necessary experience to sit for the certification exam.

Enrollment in the Histotechnician Certification Program at the University of North Dakota is highly encouraged. Entrance requirements include an Associate's Degree and minimum GPA of 2.8. Pre-requisites include four Biology credits, four Chemistry credits and college level math. Candidates will be employed by Centura Health while completing their training. What is a Histotechnician?

Histotechnicians are specialized medical lab workers. They play a role in diagnosing and treating diseases by working with tissue samples. A Histotechnician will receive a tissue sample from a patient then work closely with the lab manager using various equipment, chemicals and dyes to create slides to be examined by a pathologist for diagnostic and research purposes.

Steps to apply:

1. Join our talent community to receive information about upcoming opportunities.
2. Complete pre-requisites.
3. Submit your application to the Histotechnician Extern role.
4. Formal interview with a hiring manager.
5. Apply for acceptance at UND for the Histotechnician Certification Program, if interested.
6. Receive a formal offer of employment.

Employment outlook:

According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, employment opportunities for histotechnicians are expected to increase 11% between 2018-2028. Histotechnicians could earn from \$44,700, up to \$52,330 annually in the Denver metro area.
