Position Summary

Work as a Pharmacist in HealthSET's Health Promotion Clinics. Provide direct pharmacy consultation to low-income senior citizens.

Responsibilities

- Review medications with clients including OTC, herbal products, and nutraceuticals
- Ensure clients understand his/her medications
- Counsel about side effects, doses, drug and food interactions, and low-cost alternatives
- Assist clients with questions for doctors or pharmacists
- Educate nurses about pharmacy issues
- Documenting all clinical interventions
- Promoting preventive medicine and a healthy lifestyle
- Medication Reconciliation via email if appropriate

Other Responsibilities

- Maintains adherence to requirements of regulatory agencies as they apply to the pharmacy activities
- Participates as a member of the HealthSET team
- Bilingual (Spanish/English) a plus

Schedule

- Every clinic does not need Pharmacist counsel each month, so we have Pharmacist volunteers rotate through all our clinics. Our goal is to have a Pharmacist attend each clinic at least once a year.

Training or Certifications Required

- Must be a licensed Pharmacist in good standing in the state of Colorado

Work Environment/Physical Activities

- Ability to travel throughout the metro area to volunteer at the Health Promotion Clinics
