Longmont United Hospital Overview:

At Longmont United Hospital, we treat the entire patient to leverage the powerful connection of body, mind, and spirit in the healing process. As a Planetree® Designated Hospital, associates adhere to the highest possible standards. Here, your time at work will be spent with a supportive team of associates and leaders that value self-care, flexibility and development opportunities through cross-training and continuing education. Longmont, Colo., is home to more than 2,000 acres of parks, three public golf courses and numerous trails to hike, bike, walk or run. Located less than an hour away from the Rocky Mountain National Park (ranked the fourth most visited national park in the country in 2017 by the Denver Business Journal), you'll have easy access to the very best Colorado has to offer.

Cardiac Cath Lab Department Overview:

The Cardiac Cath Lab at Longmont United Hospital has one coronary procedure room, one interventional radiology procedure room and seven prep/recovery bays. Here, we perform diagnostic and interventional cardiac, peripheral catheterizations, loop recorders, permanent pacemaker/ internal cardiac defibrillator implants and conduct TEE and cardioversion procedures. We care for Acute Coronary Syndrome patients with STEMI and NSTEMI presentations. Our department cares for individuals on an outpatient, inpatient, and emergency basis 24/7, 365 days a year. We strive to provide exceptional care to our cardiovascular patient population. This is a desirable team to join since we are building a culture that embodies strong work ethic, respect for one another's academic knowledge and experiential background. We are looking for self-motivated, eager to learn, engaged individuals, who are open to constructive feedback and value integrity.



Emergency Department:

The Emergency Department at Longmont United Hospital is a Level III trauma center, where we care for all patients and we embody the mission of Centura Health to extend the healing ministry of Christ. This team is the right place for someone who loves emergency medicine.

Medical Intensive Care Unit (MICU):

The Medical Intensive Care Unit at Longmont United Hospital is a Medical/Surgical ICU department with 16 beds. We see a variety of trauma patients (GI bleeds, post MI patients requiring support devices or medication) and anyone in need of critical care, we also provide house telemetry overflow as needed. Our department's mission is to foster evidenced-based knowledge and education advancement, delivering the best care to our patients and their families. We have created a team where regardless of differences, we strive side-by-side to improve lives and we believe in each other! The ICU is a dynamic environment where the patients, treatments and experiences are different every day. You will find self-scheduling, multiple educational opportunities and support from Centura Health with specialty certification through a generous pay differential. Your attitude is everything in MICU and we look for individuals that can handle organized chaos and care about people.

Medical and Surgical:

The Medical & Surgical Unit at Longmont United Hospital is a 36-bed unit split into two 18-bed areas on the same floor. The 5 West area is a medical surgical unit with specialties in oncology and orthopedics. The 5 South section is a medical surgical unit with the same specialties as 5 West, but also has locked doors for the safety of its pediatric patients. Nurses float between the two areas, from shift to shift, giving them the opportunity to experience a wide variety of patient populations and disease processes while working with a supportive and collaborative interdisciplinary team (knee/hip replacement, back surgeries, colectomy, gallbladder, hysterectomy, mastectomy, amputations, appendectomy, COPD, acute/chronic renal disease, GI bleed, cancer with chemotherapy, cellulitis, RSV, bowel obstructions, diabetes, etc.). It is our mission to not only support patients and families through their most difficult times in the hospital, but to also support them on their health journey once they leave the hospital.

Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU):

The Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) at Longmont United Hospital is a unit with six beds, caring for 34-week gestation and higher-Level II special care nursery (prematurity, antibiotics, CPAP, Vent, Bilirubin therapy, etc.). We have a great team culture with a very



friendly and supportive work environment. We look for candidates with a positive attitude and who are willing to learn and work hard in a team environment.

OB Post-Partum:

The OB Post-Partum department at Longmont United Hospital has 19 LDRP beds, six Level II Special Care Nursery beds, two ORs and a three-bed triage. Our scope is Labor and Delivery, postpartum couplet care (mom & well baby), antepartum care, C-sections, tubal ligations, Level II nursery and care for babies 34 weeks and up. Our department gets occasional overflow with gynecological surgery patients. We have a strong, supportive culture with all BirthPlace associates and providers and provides a very positive team environment. The right candidate must have a positive attitude and want to work in a strongly supportive team environment. They need to be able to learn quickly and be someone who can multitask and handle ongoing change without getting flustered. This person will need to be flexible and able to work at a fast pace.

Surgery:

The surgery department at Longmont United Hospital averages around 250 cases per month. We have six ORs performing surgery for general, ortho, ophthalmology, urology, ENT, plastics, neuro, thoracic and utilizing robotics. We primarily care for adult populations and do not have overflow from other departments. Our mission is to provide excellent care for patients who require surgical care in a respectful and compassionate manner. The atmosphere is warm and open to others and we encourage all team members to have an active part in making decisions in the department. We are very supportive of those who wish to develop themselves and welcome someone who is a strong team player and enjoys a collaborative work environment. As a smaller OR, everyone must do everything at some point, and we encourage team members to help each other!

Telemetry Unit:

The Telemetry Unit department at Longmont United Hospital has 36 beds, we treat anything heart-related. We are part of a small community hospital and fill the niche for step down and med/surg overflow with a variety of acuity patients on our floor, as well as cardiac cath recovery. Our patient mix includes those with pacemaker, stroke, heart attack, arrhythmia and those with medication needs. The culture is one of prevalent kindness where we embrace new associates. We offer great schedules where new grads can learn. Being part of our team means you have good work ethic and bring the right attitude, because we can teach skill, but we cannot teach people to care for others.
