QD, qd, W.D. or Q.O.D, QOD, qod	Write QAM, "daily" and "every other day"	Missing leading zero: (Example: .5mg)	Include the preceding zero before a decimal point when the dose is less than a whole unit.
Trailing or terminal zero after decimal point (Ex: 3.0)	Do NOT use trailing or terminal zeros; write doses as whole numbers	U or u	Write out the word "units"
