### St. Anthony Summit Medical Center:

St. Anthony Summit Medical Center is a Level III trauma center serviced by Flight For Life® Colorado. We are nationally recognized by being Winners of the 2018 Guardian Excellence Award for distinction in patient experience and have also received the Pathway to Excellence designation from the American Nurses Credentialing Center as being one of the best hospitals for nurses to work in the nation. We provide a full range of medical specialties and health care services to Summit County and the surrounding areas including surgical, emergency, critical care, birth center, orthopedic, breast care, digital mammography, breast MRI, radiology and imaging, infusion therapy, nuclear medicine, cardiology, oncology, Summit Sleep Disorders Center, Ear Nose and Throat (ENT), gastroenterology and Total Joint Replacement. As part of the Centura Health network, we are proud to provide convenient care where you live, work and play - that's why visitors and residents alike can count on us for emergent and urgent medical services. In addition to 24/7, Level III emergency care at Summit Medical Center in Frisco, we have three emergency mountain clinics at the base of Breckenridge, Copper Mountain and Keystone, as well as urgent care and primary care available from CHPG High Country Healthcare.

### Emergency Department:

The Emergency Department at St. Anthony Summit Medical Center is a Level III trauma center, with specialized ortho trauma care. We also provide excellent stroke, STEMI, and sepsis care, consistently meeting benchmarks. We have a comprehensive forensic nurse examiner program and that team works closely with the ED team to consult on all intentional trauma. Our patient mix is ortho trauma, cardiac, stroke, behavioral health, substance abuse, pediatric illness and trauma. We do not get overflow from other departments. Our mission is collaboration and teamwork to promote compassionate and excellent care. Individuals would want to join our team because of our great teamwork, continuous education, development opportunities, self-scheduling, an intimate group who



really cares for one another and top patient satisfaction scores. We encourage associates to have a voice and engage in committees and focus groups to help problem solve. When hiring, we look for those who are professional and respectful in all interactions, committed to excellence, flexible, willing to work in a resource environment and who always put safety and patients first.

### **General Medical:**

The General Medical department at St. Anthony Summit Medical Center is a 16 to 26-bed blended unit meeting the daily challenges of caring for patients with a wide array of medical conditions. Our department specializes in ICU, intermediate care, medical surgical and pediatrics. The average length of stay is 1.2 days, so patients turnover quickly on this unit. The majority of patients are tourists and are dealing with the stress of injury while on vacation. We all have a variety of duties and wear multiple hats as we are a small hospital. We treat a wide variety of patients and are the only inpatient department in the hospital, so all patients come to this floor. We sometimes receive overflow for LDRP and we take care of postpartum moms and babies. Our team has an amazing culture of teamwork, high patient satisfaction and sees a variety of patients. Census changes rapidly on the floor if ICU patients come in, so we are flexible. We work with limited resources, no transporters and no IV team.

### **Obstetrics/Post-Partum:**

The Obstetrics/Post-Partum department at St. Anthony Summit Medical Center has eight beds, labor, delivery, post-partum, Level I nursery, and one OR, seeing about 35 deliveries a month. On a rare occasion we treat GYN patients. Our mission is to provide compassionate care to all as we would a family member. We work in a team-oriented environment in the highest altitude birth center in North America. Our co-workers are also our friends, and there is time to spend with patients providing thorough education and excellent care. We use a self-scheduling model to provide a strong work-life balance to be able to spend time doing the year-round outdoor activities that Summit County offers. To be part of our team, we look for a great work ethic, team player, and a love for OB.

### **Surgery:**

The Surgery department at St. Anthony Summit Medical Center has three OR suites, an average of 100 to 200 surgical cases per month, depending on the season. We specialize in orthopedic trauma, general trauma, sports medicine, OB/GYN surgery, urology and ENT. Our surgical volume is 50% ortho, 20% general, 20% OB/GYN, and 10% other services. We are one of the busiest Level III trauma centers in the state. We pride ourselves on a strong positive culture of acceptance, support and strive for personal growth. Our leadership is servant based and fully supportive of our incredible associates in all they do.

Our commitment to excellence continues with our care for our community.
