St. Thomas More Hospital Overview:

St. Thomas More Hospital, a 25-bed acute care facility, is the cornerstone of health care services for Fremont County and surrounding southern Colorado communities. St. Thomas More offers 24-hour emergency and trauma services including inpatient acute care, intensive care unit, The Birth Center, diagnostic imaging, surgical services, rehabilitation services, sleep disorder center and a community blood bank. We're proud to have a five-star rating for joint replacement and be ranked among the top 15% in the nation for total joint replacements. Our board-certified physicians specialize in emergency medicine, internal medicine, obstetrics/gynecology services, general surgery, orthopedic surgery and osteopathic treatment.

Associates of St. Thomas More enjoy the camaraderie of a close-knit community hospital, the relaxed feel of small-town life and an affordable cost of living in a town rich in culture and historic architecture. Located about 50 miles from Colorado Springs at the foothills of the Rocky Mountains and the mouth of the Royal Gorge, locals and visitors alike enjoy this area for some of the state's best hiking, wildlife and river sports like rafting and fishing.

Emergency Department:

The Emergency Department at St. Thomas More consists of 13 ED beds, three behavioral Health rooms and five fast tracks. The Emergency Department handles acute and subacute issues. We are a Level IV trauma center but are rural and critical access. We're located in a tourist area with many outdoor activities, so trauma is a big part of our care and we have a broad case mix. We see everything from major traumas, STEMIs, and strokes to minor cases of viral illness and well-child checks. We are proficient in EMTALA laws with our stabilization and transfer experience of acutely emergent patients. We see neonates to geriatrics and even treat an inmate population. Occasionally, we need to board a patient. Our culture, teamwork and team dynamics are unlike any other. We have a great relationship with our associates and physicians. Our team is our extended family. We look



for candidates that are willing to learn, are friendly, flexible and focused on providing a great patient experience.

Float Pool:

The Float Pool at St. Thomas More focuses on maximizing the abilities of our workforce and clinical associates. We offer our team members the opportunity to cross-train in different areas. We believe in cultivating our nurses from within and providing them with whatever experience and opportunities needed to reach their goals. Relationships with our physicians and surgeons are also collaborative. Many of our physicians enjoy teaching and take the time to ensure all team members understand each patient's plan of care. We look for candidates that have creative problem-solving skills, have positive attitudes, are team focused, flexible and have a patient centered attitude.

Medical Intensive Care Unit (MICU):

The Medical Intensive Care Unit (MICU) department at St. Thomas More Hospital is a four-bed unit – and two RNs staff the General Medical ICU. We do occasionally have med/surg overflow patients. Most of our patients are general critical care (resp, sepsis, post op complications, CHF, some cardiac). We do not have neuro, cardiology or in-patient trauma. Our department has great teamwork, autonomy and flexibility with self-scheduling. We are a very friendly and close-knit unit. Team members work well together and genuinely care about each other. We look for candidates that have strong clinical skills, are resourceful, flexible, have good communication and values teamwork.

Medical Surgical:

The Medical Surgical department at St. Thomas More Hospital has 25 beds and specializes in general medicine, general surgery, orthopedic surgery and GYN surgery. Our patient mix is general medical patients with varying diagnoses from COPD, pneumonia, SBO, post-op, post-op complications, simple pediatrics (RSV, Flu), telemetry and sepsis. As a Critical Access hospital, we emphasis teamwork, creativity, and problem solving. While our resources may be limited, all disciplines collaborate to take care of our patients. Our clinical associates are offered the opportunity to cross train in different areas. Our team members have many opportunities to develop professionally and reach their career goals. We have collaborative relationships with our physicians and surgeons. We look for candidates that are positive, adaptable, critical thinkers and are patient focused.

Obstetrics, Post-Partum:

The Obstetrics, Post-Partum department at St. Thomas More Hospital has four Labor, Delivery & Recovery rooms and four Postpartum rooms where we deliver about 20 babies per month and the average census is two patients. Our department is Labor & Delivery,



mom, baby, nursery and obstetrics with a patient mix of antepartum, labor, postpartum and newborn. We believe that our care toward our patients impact their life experience and we are honored to have the ability to make a positive impact. Surgery:

The Surgery department at St. Thomas More Hospital has ten SDS beds, seven PACU beds, five Infusion Center rooms, two GI lab rooms and five OR suites. We specialize in General Ortho including total joints, Urology, GYN, Bariatric, Podiatry, GI Lab and Outpatient Infusion Center. Our patient mix is surgical, endoscopy and infusion (no chemo) patients. We are on a mission to provide high quality care with zero harm to patients and associates. We are a high reliability organization with positive patient outcomes. Our department is desirable because of our dedicated team and our small community feel. We have a great work culture and high work ethics. There is a very good relationship between the associates and the surgeons. Continuing individual education and growth is highly encouraged.
